PETS ALIVE MOVING TO NEW LOCATION

BLOOMINGTON, IN - After nearly six years in their current location, the Pets Alive Nonprofit Spay/Neuter Clinic will be moving from 6522 South Empire Road near the intersection of South Walnut Street and State Road 37 to the intersection of South Walnut Street and Winslow Road at 2444 South Walnut Street. The nonprofit spay/neuter clinic will move into the site of their former consignment store, Sweet Repeats, in the Walnut Park Shopping Center.

The clinic will be closed Monday, August 29, 2011 through Monday, September 5, 2011 for the move. Beginning Tuesday, September 6, 2011, Pets Alive will be open Tuesdays through Fridays 8am to 6pm with vaccination clinics held daily from 3pm to 5pm. The new location and new hours will allow Pets Alive to continue to provide a high level of service but in a more efficient manner. An open house is scheduled for October.

“This move marks a big milestone for us and the community,” said the newly named Pets Alive Executive Director, Melissa Kusturin. “As we reach nearly 50,000 surgeries, we are inspired and motivated to strengthen our efforts to further reduce the number of unwanted animals in our communities. Local support thus far has been encouraging and is needed now as much as ever. Due to unforeseen changes in our current leasing situation, the move was not included in this year’s budget and has been a financial and logistical challenge for us as an organization. We are asking supporters to consider making a first-time or additional contribution to help us off-set these unexpected costs. Support in the form of volunteers is also needed to assist with moving locations.”

Pets Alive Spay/Neuter Clinic is a nonprofit that opened in 2005 to offer high-quality, affordable spay and neuter surgeries in the South Central Indiana area. Services have since expanded to include vaccination clinics for healthy pets and wellness medications for flea, tick and heartworm prevention such as Revolution, Frontline, and Heartgard. The standard fee of a spay or neuter surgery at Pets Alive is \$53 for any male or female dog or \$33 for any male or female cat. A rabies vaccination (as required by state law) costs \$12.
